After five years of hard work, we completed the main buildings for this ambitious project just in time and nearly all of the equipment in these photos came from the various container shipments that you helped us to send out to Ghana.

The new school will provide much-needed secondary education for over 300 girls who would rarely get such an opportunity within the limitations of the local system – but will now benefit from a high quality school with excellent resources.

You have played a key role in helping us to launch this exciting new project and get started on the next phase of our mission to support education, equality and development in North East Ghana.
